



Sport Ireland National Horse Sport Arena COVID- 19 Health & Safety Protocols

For the use of Sport Ireland National Horse Sport Arena during the phased re-opening. Management reserve the right to refuse admission for any non-compliance.

The participant hereby agrees to be bound by the policies & procedures of Sport Ireland Facilities DAC as provided/ published.

1. Users confirm they accept the protocols, terms and conditions for using the facility.
2. Users understand the risks involved and will minimise these risks by following guidelines.
3. Users confirm that they are not showing symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, fever, high temperature, sore throat, runny nose, breathlessness or flu like symptoms) presently nor in the past 14 days.
4. Users confirm that they have not come into contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.
5. Users confirm that they have not been diagnosed with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 infection in the last 14 days, nor have I been advised to self-isolate or cocoon at this time.
6. Users acknowledge that the facility has taken measures to minimise the risk but cannot eliminate the risk.
7. Users confirm permission for their data to be used for contact tracing to avoid the spread of COVID-19, with data retained following GDPR guidelines.
8. Any customer attending the National Horse Sport Arena confirms that they have not displayed any symptoms of COVID-19, and have not been diagnosed with or have a suspected COVID-19 infection in the last 14 days and have not been in contact with anyone who has or suspected to have a COVID-19 infection. Nor have they been advised to self-isolate or cocoon at this time.
9. Booking in advance is required for all customers before using the facility. Bookings can only be made online. The Customer's name, telephone number, email and names of those attending the booking must be provided at time of booking for contract tracing purposes.
10. Shared booking access is limited to 2 horses and groups of no more than four people inclusive of riders/coach/ trainers/ groom. Exclusive booking access is limited to 4 horses and groups of no more than four people inclusive of riders/coach/ trainers/ groom.
11. Booking times are designated to 45 minute slots. Customers may not enter the Arena before the designated booking time and must vacate it immediately afterwards, following the one-way system in operation.
12. All visitors must use the provided hand sanitiser when entering and exiting their booking area.
13. Toilet and stables facilities are remaining closed to the public. All customers must not request staff for access during this time.
14. We appreciate your support in understanding and adhering to these restrictions and would ask all users that you do not request access to any closed/unavailable facilities.
15. The timetable for use of National Horse Sport Arena is subject to change at short notice, any such changes will be notified via the bookings App, Sport Ireland Campus Website and Social Media pages.
16. Spectators are not permitted anywhere on the premises.
17. There is limited access to equipment, provided the user complies with sanitising guidelines before and after equipment usage. Where possible the National Horse Sport Arena Operative will move equipment for riders during the booking slot.

18. Any accidents and incidents must be reported to Management immediately.
19. Social distancing of a minimum of 2m must always be observed and 5m social distancing between horse boxes/ lorries.
20. Any customer attending the National Horse Sport Arena confirms that they live within a 5km radius of the facility. Travel beyond 5km to exercise is not permitted in Phase 1 on the roadmap for reopening business and society. It is important that we all play our part to ensure all phases of the roadmap are kept to the plan.

Sport Ireland Facilities DAC Policies and Rules

1. All slots will start and end according to designated booking time slot.
2. Your booking time slot includes any setting up/dismantling/removal of equipment requested or utilised for the booking.
3. Bookings are non-refundable
4. Unless there is an exclusive booking, the National Horse Sport Arena is a shared facility and bookers will need to cooperate with each other for duration of their booking and ensure social distancing of 2m.
5. All coaches must be Garda Vetted and approved.
6. Where relevant, clubs/ organisations will be required to provide proof of insurance and/or indemnity for the Sport Ireland Facilities DAC.
7. Sport Ireland Facilities DAC Management reserves the right to amend and add to the Policies and Rules and the Users/Members shall observe any amended or additional conditions or rules.
8. Sport Ireland Facilities DAC staff are entitled to dignity, respect and cooperation in the workplace and will not tolerate any form of aggressive or abusive behaviour.
9. Continued violation of any rules set down by Sport Ireland Campus Facilities DAC may result in booking/event being refused or stopped.
10. The Sport Ireland Campus Facilities adheres to Equal Status Act 2000 – 2015.
11. Members/users, patrons and their guests must always treat the facilities, its staff and other members with courtesy and respect. Membership and/or usage may be terminated or revoked for violation of any rules or regulations of the Company or for conduct deemed by the management to be detrimental to the welfare, good order, safety or character of the facility or its members.
12. Sport Ireland Campus Facilities DAC staff reserve the right to withdraw all or any part of the facilities for any periods where required for events, competitions/training, or in connection with repairs, alteration or maintenance work.
13. Liability for damages to the premises will be charged to the client accordingly. The broker of any event/booking is held responsible for any damages to the premises by a contractor acting on its behalf.
14. Sport Ireland Facilities DAC has a no smoking/no vaping policy on campus and in all facilities, apart from designated areas. Additionally, alcohol is not permitted on the grounds of the Facility.
15. Sport Ireland Facilities DAC training areas cannot be sub-let.
16. Users agree that Sport Ireland Facilities DAC is not liable for articles damaged, lost or stolen in or about the facility, or in its lockers, or for loss or damage to any property including but not limited to automobiles and the contents thereof.
17. Personal details requested during the booking process are used for administration purposes only. Personal data is not disclosed to any third party without consent. SIF's Privacy Policy clarifies usage, processing and protection of personal information in line with the EU's General
